Behaviors of Concern

Behaviors of concern are behaviors that could indicate the potential for an individual to engage in violent behavior or self-harm.

Many ...

- different behaviors
- taken together
- may be predictive

CARE Team

Napa Valley College CARE Team
(Campus Assessment and Response)

The CARE Team responds to reports of unusual or concerning behavior by systematic assessments and intervention. The team manages each case by identifying and collaborating with the most appropriate resource(s) to resolve the situation and mitigate the risks for the safety of all concerned. The team also provides outreach and education to the campus community about behaviors of concern.

NVCPD Threat Assessment

Ensure safety of involved parties, the college, and yourself.

Use the NVCPD Investigative Checklist.

Determine if there is a threat.

Take appropriate actions.

Is there need for continued monitoring?

Is there need for referral?

Keep RP apprised of actions and thank them for reporting the information.
