All employees of the Napa Valley Community College District (NVCCD) are expected to maintain the highest ethical standard in accordance with all applicable laws, regulations, professional standards, NVCCD policies and administrative regulations, and collective bargaining agreements.

Those acting on behalf of the NVCCD have a responsibility to conduct themselves in a manner that will maintain and strengthen the public's trust and confidence in the integrity of the NVCCD. Further, employees of the college are expected to treat others with respect and to demonstrate a commitment to excellence in education without compromising the principles of ethical behavior.

With regard to professional conduct, employees of the NVCCD shall model and encourage the core values of the college, including honesty, integrity, responsibility, and respect for others.
