Pursuant to Education Code Sections 70902(b); and 78016; Title 5, Sections 51022, and 55130, the programs and curricula of the District shall be of high quality, relevant to community and student needs, and evaluated regularly to insure quality and currency. To ensure quality and currency, the Superintendent/President, using the District mutual agreement process, shall establish procedures for cyclical program review.

- ~~• Regular review and justification of programs and course descriptions;~~
- ~~• Opportunities for training persons involved in aspects of curriculum development;~~
- ~~• Consideration of job market and other related information for vocational and occupational programs.~~

~~All new programs and program deletions shall be approved by the Board of Trustees.~~

~~New courses that are not part of an existing approved program and all new programs shall be submitted to the Office of the Chancellor for the California Community Colleges for approval as required.~~
