6. Information Items

6.1. Trial for new safety app –A. Wade

- SafeGuard OES is an app for mobile devices for faculty in classrooms in case of emergency. It is a safety measure that campus police has been working on.
- SafeGaurd OES works on wifi but if campus network is down it can work on cell phone signal.
- Very easy to use but requesting feedback from faculty. If anyone is interested contact Amber Wade to try it.

- It is an app for your cell phone so you would need your cell phone with you in the classroom.
- Multiple features offer map, chat and alert severity that goes to campus police.
- App has been tested in several classrooms.
- This app is in addition to NVC safety app. It is just for faculty use.
- Still looking into putting app on computers in classrooms.
- Comment from faculty member who tried app reports that it was quick and easy. Recommends trying it.
- Training on the app will take place before implemented.
- App uses sensors in each room to locate classroom on map of app.

- Request made to get all feedback earlier next time.
