

## **Academic Senate Reports for 10/9/18**

### **Tech Committee Report:**

Veteran's Day weekend, update:

- The power will not be pulled to any component, barring a huge catastrophe.
- IT met with Napa Electric and they determined alternate power could be supplied to all network and firewall components. While the back-up batteries and their associated circuits will be pulled and replaced, an alternate line of power can be supplied while that is being done.
- The power situation is still more unpredictable than your average weekend because there will be work being done in and around these components - but we should expect minimal interruption to Canvas, Office365 or WebAdvisor.

### **Facilities Committee Report:**

- The Facilities committee is looking at the capital projects we need to do in light of the decision to not go after a bond this election. The district has allocated approximately \$650,000 for capital projects in the next budget. The decision on what project to do in what order is influenced by many factors, including future planned renovations for that area.
- The college is considering hiring a company to do a space utilization study to help us plan our usage more efficiently.
- There is over 6 million dollars worth of scheduled maintenance that needs to be done on the campus, there is not that much money in the budget for the maintenance.
- The board has been looking at developers to plan a possible housing project on campus. The board will be putting out a request for proposal for conducting a housing feasibility study. This will be not limited to just student housing.
