

## Articulation Approval Timelines for 2019-20 Curriculum Submissions

Course Proposal Term	Type of Articulation	Proposals in CurricUNET Must Have <u>Local Approval</u> By	Articulation External Submission Deadline (annually)	Effective Academic Year/Term (upon approval) with specified Articulation
Fall 2019 or Spring 2020	<b>CSU transferability</b> Courses numbered 100-299 at NVC, locally determined per <a href="#">CSU EO 167</a> .	March 12 <sup>th</sup> BOT	N/A – Locally approved	Locally determined (typically upcoming academic year after local approval, 2020-21)
Fall 2019 or Spring 2020	<b>UC Transferability (UC-TCA)</b> UC Office of the President (UCOP) approves transfer level courses as specified in <a href="#">TCA policy</a>	March 12 <sup>th</sup> BOT	July 2020	Typically 2020-21  (see examples below)
Fall 2019 or Spring 2020	<b>CSU-General Education</b> Transfer GE pattern designed for CSU transfers whereby courses are approved per <a href="#">CSU EO 1100</a>	March 12 <sup>th</sup> BOT	December 2020	Typically 2021-22  (see examples below)
Fall 2019 or Spring 2020	<b>IGETC</b> Transfer GE pattern designed for UC transfers (accepted by UC and CSU) whereby courses are approved per the <a href="#">IGETC Standards</a>	March 12 <sup>th</sup> BOT	December 2020	Typically 2021-22 (The course must already be an approved UC-TCA course to be considered for IGETC)  (see examples below)
Fall 2019 or Spring 2020	<b>C-ID</b> The course must align to C-ID Descriptor for which it is being proposed. For Descriptors: <a href="http://www.c-id.net">www.c-id.net</a>	March 12 <sup>th</sup> BOT	Continuous	Effective Date as approved by C-ID.

## Understanding the Articulation Timeline, Examples & Best Practice

Best Practice: For UC Transferability and Transfer GE (IGETC/CSU GE) proposals, faculty should consider aligning the begin date of the modified course or new course with the effective articulation approval term. Examples follow:

### **UC Transfer Course Agreement (UC-TCA) a.k.a UC Transfer course proposals**

Courses submitted in July as proposed additions to NVC's UC-TCA are typically approved for the upcoming fall term. Annual decisions are received by October 1. Locally-approved courses from the previous curriculum cycle are submitted in July and pending approval, are considered active TCA courses with an upcoming fall term approval.

\*Best Practice: TCA course proposals also seeking CSU GE and/or IGETC may be "packaged" with the same (later) approval term

### **CSU GE Breadth and IGETC a.k.a. Transfer GE course proposals**

Course proposals for NVC's CSU GE Breadth or IGETC approved lists are no longer retroactively approved. Approval terms are assigned based on the following academic year in which the course is submitted. For IGETC, courses must have prior UC-TCA approval before the December submission period.

### **Actual examples from prior 2018-19 Curriculum Cycle:**

#### **Example 1 – Substantial Course Modification**

Request to maintain existing articulation for ANTH 120 – resubmission required due to substantive changes.

- Re-submit for UC-TCA in July 2019; re-approval of UC transferability effective Fall 2019 (currently pending)
- Once reapproved for TCA, re-submit for CSU GE – B1 & B2/IGETC – 5B & 5C Dec. 2019; re-approval of transfer GE effective Fall 2020 (pending submission/approval this December)

#### **Example 2 – New Course**

Request new articulation for ANTH 201

- Submit for UC-TCA in July 2019; approval of UC transferability effective Fall 2019 (currently pending)
- No GE Credit requested

#### **Example 3 - New Course**

Request new articulation for DART 101

- Submit for UC-TCA in July 2019; approval of UC transferability effective Fall 2019
- Submit for both CSU GE and IGETC areas in Dec 2019; approval of transfer GE effective Fall 2020
