We offer support with both the UC application and the UC admission/transfer process through workshops, toolkits, Personal Insight Question response draft reviews, and other resources.

Our coordinators (transfer students of color currently at Berkeley) serve as mentors not only to hold you accountable to your assignments, but to be an on-campus resource for you.

You will choose **3 out of 7** 350 word-max *Personal Insight Questions* prompts.

One is required, asking you to describe how you've prepared for your intended major once you transfer.


Introduction: This worksheet is designed to help transfer applicants start the writing process for the personal insight questions for the UC undergraduate application. We've identified a subset of questions that will guide you to answering the questions accurately and thoroughly. There is no "right answer." However, here's some things you want to include and avoid:

Google Classroom

We track assignments and progress via **Google Classroom**. (Don't worry, we'll teach you how to navigate the platform.)

Here you will upload your PIQ drafts, as well as find worksheets, toolkits, and announcements of workshops throughout both the Fall and Spring semester.

Program Application

Eligibility:

- Identify as Black, Latinx, Native American or Pacific Islander
 - 1st generation & low-income students encouraged to applu
- Minimum of a 3.0 GPA
- Must be applying for Fall 2025 admission
 - o This means you will submit a UC application by Nov. 2024
- Must complete 60 transferable units by Spring 2025
- Those who may not meet eligibility criteria can become part of our **Ambassador Program** through the same app.
