



ADN Program Cost

Approximate Total Program Cost is around \$7,000: Each student will incur a one-time upfront payment for multiple electronic resources that will give them access for the entire two year program: multiple electronic resources, like case studies, electronic books, online quizzing & NCLEX review (about \$2,650), initial two sets of uniforms & shoes (about \$500.), clinical supplies (about \$120), and Verified Credentials (online document platform with background check and drug screen- about \$146).

In addition, each semester students will have to pay Napa Valley College tuition, college registration fees (\$550/semester), lab kits (\$330), & clinical site onboarding fees (\$30). At the end of the program nursing school graduates are required to register & send new 'Livescan' fingerprints to the BRN (approximately \$300). Once they verified that you met all graduation requirements, you will then need to pay for the NCLEX-RN exam (currently approximately \$200 fee to test), so be prepared!!
