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### ICD-10-CM

- International Classification of Diseases
- Clinical descriptions of mental and behavior disorders
  - 2 broad classifications
  - Subclassifications

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## **Psychiatric Technicians**

- Employed in a variety of settings

- The North American Nursing Diagnosis Association International
- (NANDA-I) describes a nursing diagnosis as a clinical judgment about individual, family, or community responses to actual or potential health problems and life processes.
