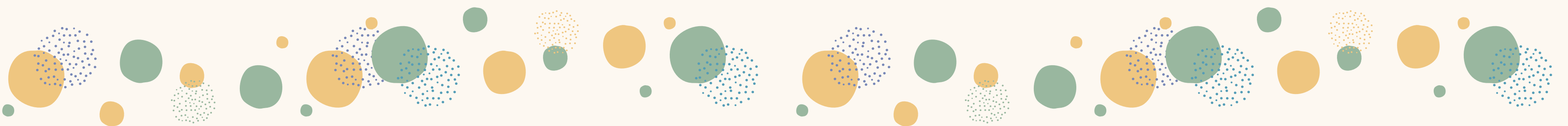




Advisory Committee Purpose





California College Fairs

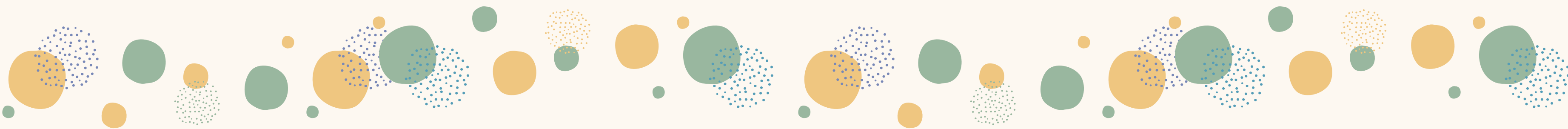

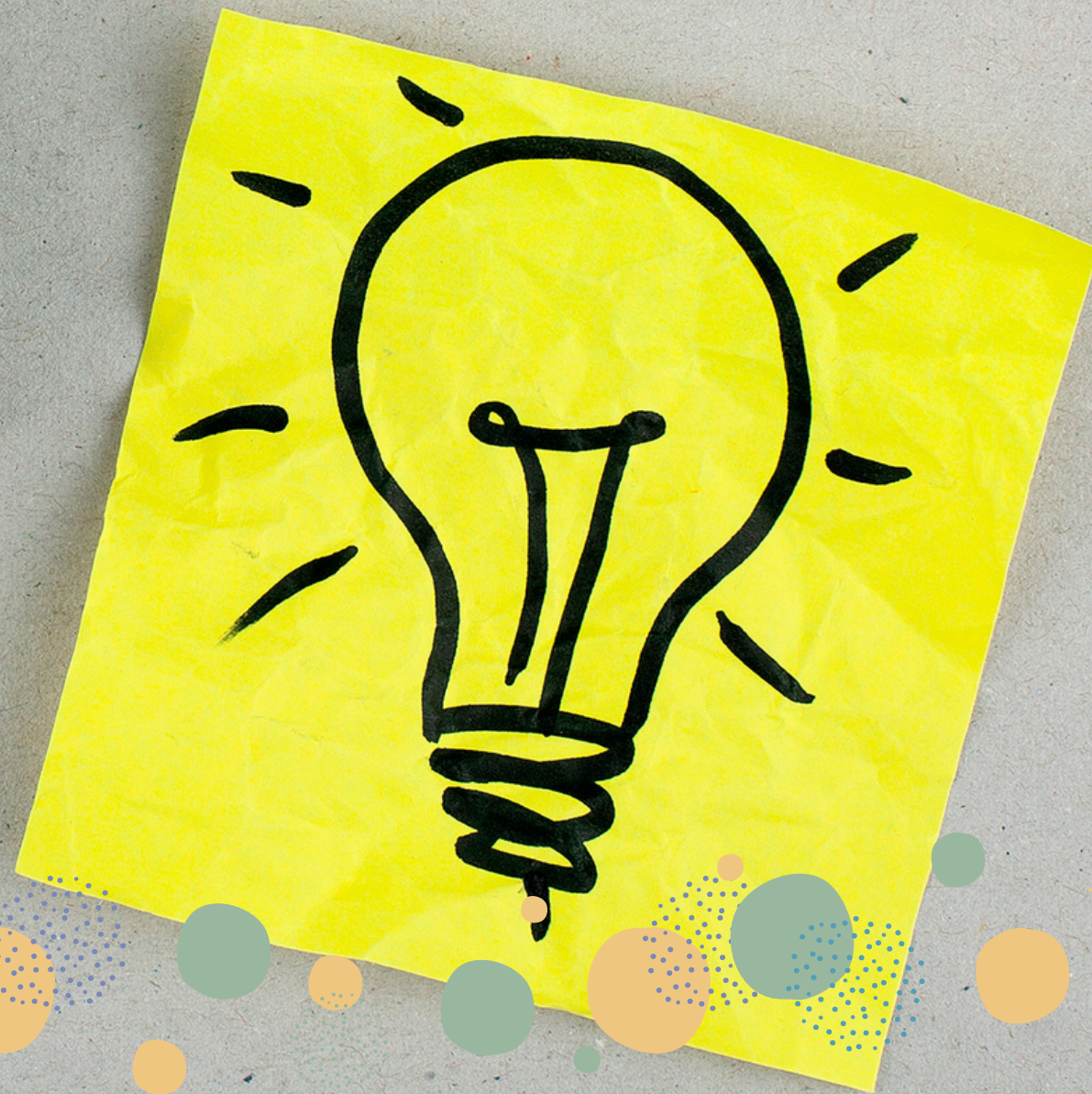
